Bread for the World (BFW) -- BFW is a collective Christian voice urging our nation's decision makers to end hunger at home and abroad by changing policies, programs and conditions that allow hunger and poverty to persist. www.bread.org.

CSA - Community Supported Agriculture -- St. Sebastian parish volunteers have coordinated weekly deliveries of fresh, certified organic and sustainably grown vegetables during the growing season. CSA provides a direct link to a system of farming you can see, know and trust.

Society of Saint Vincent de Paul (SVdP) -- The Society of Saint Vincent de Paul helps parishioners and non-parishioners with emergency needs of clothing, food, rent, utilities, appliances, beds, etc. Volunteers make home visits based on referrals from parish, assess the family's social condition and refer to appropriate community agencies if indicated, and provide vouchers for food, clothing, furniture, etc.
